CAUTION TO SELLER:

In order for the certificate to be accepted in good faith by the seller, the seller must exercise care that the property being sold is of a type normally sold wholesale, resold, or utilized as an ingredient or component part of a product manufactured by the buyer in the usual course of his business. A seller failing to exercise due care could be held liable for the sales tax due. Purchasers claiming an exemption from sales tax on its purchases are required to file a Certificate of Resale with the seller. A new resale certificate should be provided to the seller annually. Contractor's Excise Tax and Use Tax license numbers are not valid resale numbers. (Examples: 53E-00000-0, 53-00000-0-E, 75U-00000-0, or 75-00000-0-U) If the purchaser does not furnish a valid certificate of resale, the seller is liable for sales tax on its receipts from such sales. Sales of items or services to the user or consumer do not qualify as exempt sales.
